We have also invited Former-President of the Commission of Inquiry on Human Rights in the Democratic People's Republic of Korea, the UN, Former- Ambassador for North Korean Human Rights, the Government of the Republic of Korea and Ambassador Extraordinary and Plenipotentiary of the United Kingdom to the Republic of Korea to discuss the current situation in North Korea and the ways to resolve the abductions issue.
